This location is very close to the street address: 142 E. Westmont Ave, Norfolk, VA 23503. The parade steps off at 10:00AM.

Beforehand, we will meet between 8:15AM and 8:30AM at the Southern Shopping center behind the Bojangles (7519 Tidewater Drive, Norfolk, VA 23505) there you will be asked to sign the customary NCCC Waiver Form. At 8:30AM the Beachcombers will drive together (about 2 miles) and make a left on Westmont Avenue to the parade staging location. By all means bring decorations for your car and wear attire appropriate as long as its green!

Right now, we have all 10 car slots filled, but by all means please sign up as an alternate! Last year after exhausting all alternates we rolled in the parade only 8 cars participating having room for 2 more.

The after party starts after the parade (approximately noon) and ends at 4PM. The after party free and open to everyone who is 21 years of age or older. So even if you're not in the parade, think about going to the afterparty!
