We will have a guest speaker, Dwight Farmer, at our July Business meeting on July 2nd. Dwight Farmer lives in Suffolk and has quite a corvette background!!! ... He has been a member of NCRS since 1981 and was a founding member of the Mid-Atlantic chapter. He was a team lead for judging of 58-60 Corvettes. He was a founding member of our National Corvette Museum. He is a former President and VP of the NCM. He currently owns a 1960 he purchased from original, a fully documented restored 1959 fuelie, a 1967 427/400 Tri-power AC convertible with 40,000 original miles, a 2019 ZR1 purchased new. Know that when you fill out this regional form to mail, you can check a box if you need a room in Bowling Green and what is your departure date from Bowling green (Sunday, September 1st). Other Beachcombers who have done so, received information about the hotel arrangements to be made in Bowling Green, Asheville and Sevierville. The Foothills Corvette Club (FCC) is expected to hosts their annual event as indicated from their recent newsletters. The date for the Run is Sunday, October 27th with a possible car show on Saturday, October 26th. I'm still hopeful to hear from them before long with details, but being concerned about hotels filling in the area, it is best to book a refundable room now. It may be best to book at least Friday and Saturday nights the 25th and 26th. Then for Sunday after the run, it's a 5+ hour drive from Virginia Beach, it would be possible to drive home on Sunday after the run/luncheon but it would be a late home arrival. Optionally a stay over Sunday night near the luncheon location (or back in N. Wilkesboro) and drive home on Monday the 28th.

<u>Last year</u>, the Sunday Run to the Colors event started at the North Wilkesboro Speedway (here) heading north for a luncheon at the Olde Beau Resort & Golf Club in Roaring Gap, NC. All met at the speedway at 8:30AM, drivers meeting at 10:00AM, drive starts at 11:00AM. Its approximately a 1-hour drive to the Resort for lunch. Holiday/Christmas Party - DoubleTree by Hilton, VB

We have reached out to the DoubleTree and we have met the new Director of Catering. Fortunately, there was a recent cancellation for Saturday, December 7th for which she is now holding for us until after our July 2nd business meeting. They have two other possible dates as of June 18th. These dates are Friday, December 13th and Friday, December 20th. We have a minimum of a \$6,000 food and beverage order. We were looking at buffet like last year serving 3 proteins, 1 starch, 1 vegetable, salad, rolls, condiments, hors d'oeuvres trays, cheeses/fruits/berries, desserts, coffee and iced tea. We have until 30 days prior to determine the menu and until 7 days prior to determine attendance. We will have a block of rooms for our group for those who wish to stay overnight. Last year each room was \$109/night (plus taxes and fees) and we were verbally quoted to be \$99/night (plus taxes and fees). Still to do is the identify the cost of a hospitality room (on the 12th floor) for the after party as in years past. The club typically allocates \$3,500 from our annual budget and then uses a portion of dues collected for membership in November and other monies collected through the year (to include proceeds from Vettes at Waterside District, as well as inviting sponsors to attend the party to defray the perperson cost. The costs last year were \$35/member, \$35/first guest, \$60/non-member. We will be discussing the details at the July 2nd business meeting to determine if the club wishes to proceed and contract with the DoubleTree again, or choose a different venue. Last year, our party was at the DoubleTree and was held on Saturday, December 16th.
